

Five 'I wills' of Self-exaltation

Isaiah 14

1. I will ascend to heaven.
2. I will exalt my throne above the stars.
3. I will sit on mountain of the Most High.
4. I will ascend above the heights.
5. I will be like the Most High.

In these declarations Lucifer sowed the seeds of rebellion and self-exaltation into the earth. Through Adam's fall, the sins of Lucifer's rebellion were seeded into mankind. This is the root of our sin nature. The door was opened to our own self-exaltation, as self on the throne! There are the 'I wills' of the flesh. These 5 'I wills' are expressed in the 5 giants: self-will, selfish ambition, self-protection, self-righteousness and self-preservation. Satan authored rebellion and spread it like a poison through the giants. The attributes of the enemy taken to the fullest expression and multiplied globally becomes the fullness of evil! God had a Covenant and a Savior! He reached out from the beginning with His plan of redemption!

Five 'I wills' of Self-surrender

Genesis 12:1-3

1. I will make of you a great nation.
2. I will bless you.
3. I will make your name great.
4. I will bless those who bless you.
5. I will curse him who curses you.

The Covenant of God brings His redemption. That Covenant with Abraham opened for us the pathway to relationship and Sonship. God recognized Abraham as one marked to pioneer a divine plan, and Abraham chose obedience. He submitted his will to God. That plan involved a willing heart to know and worship God and a humble heart to bow and obey. In order for us to victoriously conquer the 5 'I wills' of self we have to follow Abraham's pattern of surrender. For God's agents of glory, it is of prime importance to say yes to surrender, humility and obedience. Though the enemy sowed the seeds of sin into mankind, God answered with Jesus and the cross including the five New Testament 'I wills' as His divine remedy!

Five 'I wills' of the Fullness of God

2 Corinthians 6:14-18

1. I will dwell in them.
2. I will walk among them.
3. I will be their God.
4. I will receive/welcome them.
(meaning - favor/communion)
5. I will be Father to them and they shall be my Sons and Daughters.

The posture of the mature sons and daughters of the Almighty is surrender, humility and obedience. The God of Dominion is taking residence within including power-encounters. 2 Cor. 6:17 says, "*Come out from among them And be separate...*" These 'I wills' open the door to glory because they open the door to the benefits of mature sacrificial sonship which brings forth the fullness of God in the last days. Maturity is a qualifier for those He is preparing as His vessels of His glory! These mature ones will perceive and discern accurately the Mighty One dwelling within. These vessels of honor in whom the Almighty resides will be the Joel 2 army for the end-times! That takes you into residency in the New Jerusalem as being a pillar for the church and sign to the world.
