

Purpose: A strategic and apostolic perspective of the minister called to equip others and mobilize an army of deliverance workers. The questions to be answered:

1. How to teach people self-deliverance?
2. How to equip them to deliver others?
3. What do I and KBI have to offer?

Notes:

1. What is deliverance?

1.1. Scripture and Charge commissioning believers

*And he (Jesus) said to them, **Go** into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who **believe**: in my name **they will cast out demons**; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover. Mark 16:15-18*

1.2. Bondage can look different based on what area needs deliverance

1. **Evil Spirits:** God's authority over spiritual forces (Mark 5:1-20, Luke 10:17-20).
2. **Earthly woes** (disease, dangers, death) God rescue from physical harm - Israelites crossing the Red Sea (Exodus 14:13-31) or Daniel saved from the lions (Daniel 6:16-23) and Jesus healed the sick (Mat 8:16-17, Luke 8:43-48).
3. **Emotional and Psychological.** God delivers His people from fear, anxiety, and despair (Psalm 34:4, 2 Timothy 1:7, Psalm 40:1-3).
4. **Enticed** (Enticement) God provide a way out of temptation (1 Cor 10:13) and from evil (Mat 6:13).
5. **Eternal.** Victory over Death and the Grave: Jesus' resurrection ensures deliverance from the power of death (1 Cor 15:54-57) and salvation that promises eternal life (John 3:16, Romans 8:1-2).
6. **Enemy oppressors** Egypt (Exodus 3:7-10), nations during the time of the judges (Judges 2:16-19) or Israel from Babylonian captivity (Isaiah 45:1-13, Ezra 1:1-4).



*But when one turns to the Lord, the **veil is removed**. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being **transformed** into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit. 2 Corinthians 3:16-18*

2. **Apostolic perspective** – Conviction and commission to truth and biblical teaching
Matthew 6:13 says, "And lead us not into temptation, that we may be trying, and lead us not into evil, and have not in us any evil intention (**eliminate it**), and nor have in us any evil deed." **Proverbs 24:11** says, "And many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved." (**Face it**)
3. How to teach people self-deliverance?
 - 3.1. They must face their **FEAR**
 - **Face it** – be willing to be real with yourself and God
 - **Eliminate it** – stop loving it and cast it out
 - **Accept it** – receive God’s healing and deliverance
 - **Redeem it** – use what God has purchased to destroy darkness
 - 3.2. The most used prayer pattern we use is **IDO**
 - **Identify** the target
 - **Destroy** the target
 - **Occupy** the land
4. **How to equip ministers?** Teach people that
 - 4.1. Deliverance is a biblical key used to free people from bondage as it affects people
 - physically through sickness/disease and addictions.
 - spiritually through possession and oppression.
 - mentally through depression and torment.
 - financially through poverty and greed.
 - emotionally through fear, anger, and anxiety.
 - relationally through pride and control.
 - 4.2. Bringing people into the **FOLD** is a key for remaining free
 - **F**orgiveness – JOY (Jesus, others and you)
 - **O**bedience - extreme to GO give order
 - **L**ove - Christ, not crisis
 - **D**esperate - Boldness to overcome fear

5. Additional potential topics for freestyle.

- 5.1. I'll open it up at the end for questions. Matt 6:13 deliver us from the evil one.... Proverbs 24:11 Deliver those who are drawn toward death, And hold back those stumbling to the slaughter.... Let's look at this from an apostolic (big picture view) what ought senior ministers consider when they look at equipping their people in the deliverance ministry.

- 5.3. What is deliverance ministry?
- 5.4. Are there levels of deliverance.
- 5.5. Can people self-deliver?

- 5.7. Once delivered, is there anything they have to do to maintain it?
